Lara Moore also reported to the committee that Becker Construction has been given to "go-ahead" and will begin work on the Track & Turf project this week. Completion of the project is set for fall 2018. The Loso Hall renovation will begin next year and the Data Center will be moving to Ackerman. Planning will begin on the fieldhouse project very soon.
