7. Requirements for Certificates
  - The committee discussed the need to implement a minimum number of courses. EPCC approved the certificate form that currently states 20-45 credits are required but we may need to re-think that.
  - Do technical certificates require a different amount of credits?

- Do students have to be admitted to earn a certificate? No
- Change certificate language:
  - Institutional Requirements: Fewer credits may be acceptable if there is a strong, coherent skills-based justification.
  - Requirements for a certificate: D. Students must complete the coursework with a "C-" or better to count towards the certificate, with an overall cumulative GPA of 2.0 for the certificate. Individual programs may impose higher standards as a condition for awarding the certificate.
